

# Ten Commandments for RVICS Missionary Members

1. Accept assignments and direction given you each day by your Team Leader joyfully and as unto the Lord. *Colossians 3:23-24*
2. Do the work assigned you to the best of your ability, contributing your own experience as necessary. *Colossians 3:17*
3. Be a good team player. Serve faithfully along with your team members, not allowing your ego to become fractured if your ideas are not used at times. Remember, others may have some better ideas on how to do the job in question. The Team Leader will make the final decision. *Colossians 3:12-13*
4. Keep in mind the Project Host may want the job done differently than the way you think it should be done. These instructions are given to your Team Leader to pass on to you. Remember, we are committed to doing what is asked of us, if at all possible. *Proverbs 13:13*
5. Never expect anything monetary or material for your work as a volunteer, other than a place to park your RV. *James 2:14, James 1:22*
6. Always keep in mind that shortages of finances are experienced by many of the ministries we serve. Therefore, members serving at such ministries should understand and accept the necessity to work with used materials and why, at times, there may be a lack of needed materials. After all, we are helping them because they are worthy and needy. *Hebrews 6:10*
7. When you ride with someone, make certain you offer to contribute to their vehicle expenses. They should not be expected to withstand the expenses themselves. *Romans 13:8*
8. Before requesting special furlough time, make certain the time requested is essential and not for something less important than your commitment to the Lord. Remember, the Lord knows the intent of your heart. *Proverbs 16:2*
9. Always be loyal to your Team Leader and the RVICS Ministry and refrain from unwarranted criticism. *Matthew 7:1-2, Luke 18:20-30*
10. Take pride in being a Missionary in the Lord's work and do everything assigned you as unto the Lord. The rewards are treasures of the Spirit and are out of this world. *Matthew 7:20-21*
